1. Best prepared & presented goat, any age, any breed. It is recommended that each exhibitor, exhibit at least 1 animal in this class (NO ENTRY FEE)

5. Anglo Nubian Doe in milk under 3 years

16. TYPE & PRODUCTION FIRST LACTATION 24 HOUR TEST. To be judged for type only out of 100 points. Does to have participated in a 24-hour milk test any where in Australia within the last 2 years of the date of the show. Test to be nominated and points gained stated on the entry form. Photo-copy of the test is requested with entry. Copy will be returned at the show.
  
17. TYPE & PRODUCTION 2ND OR SUBSEQUENT LACTATION 24 HOUR TEST. To be judged for type only out of 100 points. Does to have participated in a 24-hour milk test any where in Australia within the last 2 years of the date of the show. Test to be nominated and points gained stated on the entry form. Photo-copy of the test is requested with entry. Copy will be returned at the show.
  
18. TYPE & PRODUCTION HERD RECORDING to be judged for type only out of 100 points. Does must have been herd recorded, anywhere in Australia within the last 2 years of the date of the show. Photo-copy of approved record is requested with entry. Copy will be returned at the show.
  
19. Best Udder, 1st lactation. To be judged in milk and then milked out.
20. Best Udder, 2nd or subsequent lactation. To be judged in milk and then milked out

Best uddered British Alpine Doe to be judged within these 2 classes

- 59. Group of 3 Bucks & or Does. Senior, Junior (1 year & under 2 years) and Kid ( under 12 months), owned but not necessarily bred by the exhibitor. (Senior Buck must be over 2 years, Senior Doe need not be over 2 years, but must have kidded)
- 60. Sire's Progeny: 2 progeny of 1 buck, progeny to be over 2 years
- 61. Sire's Progeny: 2 progeny of 1 buck, progeny to be under 2 years
- 62. 2 MILKING DAUGHTERS of 1 buck, both to be owned by the exhibitor
- 63. Dam & Progeny, any age, both to be owned by exhibitor, (Progeny may be Bucks or Does)
- 64. BREEDER'S PLATE: Sire, Dam & 1 progeny. To be owned & bred by the exhibitor
- 65. Junior Handler under 12 years of age.
- 66. Junior Handler 12 years and under 18 years of age.
